

Attention Bak Parents & Students: Bak MSOA Students must adhere to the following for all after school and night events/performances:

1. Students may not stay after school without adult supervision to attend an athletic event, club, activity, or performance.
2. Students enrolled in After Care (Curtain Calls) may attend if accompanied by a school employee/after school counselor.

Per the School District of Palm Beach County: Event Rules For ALL Attendees/Entrance to Gym

- All persons, bags, and vehicles may be subject to search and/or wandung.
- Only clear bags are permitted inside the gym - All other bags or purses, with the exception of diaper bags, are prohibited
- No re-entry: If you exit, you cannot return
- No admittance after the start of the second half of the final game
- No loitering outside of the gym/stadium/school gates or in parking areas
- Exit the gym/stadium immediately at the conclusion of the final game
- No outside food or beverages may be brought into the event
- Unruly conduct, disruptive behavior, use of profane, obscene or abusive language of any type will result in immediate removal from the event
- In the event of an emergency or inclement weather, follow all instructions provided by law enforcement or school staff
- If the event is held at a middle school, the students, athletes, and cheerleaders of the home school will use an alternative middle school entrance, designated by the principal, to the event and not through the public screening entrance; provided that:
 - 1) The athlete or cheerleader brought the backpack with them at the beginning of their school day AND the athlete or cheerleader has NOT left campus
- Visiting team coaches/players/cheerleaders can come through that special entrance without having their bags checked provided they came directly from their home school.

ALL other attendees (volunteers, parents, spectators, etc.) shall enter through the public entrance and are to be screened according to this policy.
